### Work Experience

**All** students in Y10 from September will be doing their Work Experience from Monday 4<sup>th</sup> February to Friday 15<sup>th</sup> February 2019. Forms have been given out to the students, so can you please check that your son/daughter has brought them home, along with an information sheet. They do need to be signed by both a parent/guardian and the student.

**Pink Forms** are to be used if the student is contacting an employer themselves to arrange a private placement, and the form must be returned by **Friday 7<sup>th</sup> September**.

**Yellow Forms** are to be completed and handed in if your son/daughter wants Mrs Brown to help them find a placement. These forms have to be handed in by **Friday 20<sup>th</sup> July** at the latest. Details on this form must include three types of industry the student would like to work in and how far they can travel to get to work.

Students can hand in a yellow form and also continue to try to find a private placement.

Please check that the student knows which form to use, and when the deadline is. If they have any queries they can come along to the Careers Office to speak to Mrs Brown. We have a list of employers who we have used in the past, and who may be happy to take students again in February 2019.
