Trips and Visits

This half term has been a busy one in the Geography department – fifty four GCSE students in Y10 and Y11 have been to Lee on Solent to study the sediments depositing along the groyne on the beach and the land use on the high street, whilst trying to find elusive tourists on a day with 25mph winds! Luckily the sun shone and data was collected; this has been collated and analysed in depth in preparation for their Paper 3 examination in the summer of 2019. Practice exam questions have been completed and are showing positive reflections on the activities and experiences.

Forty eight Y8 students came with the department to Hengistbury Head in Dorset to study the cliffs, beach and spit at this fantastic site of special scientific interest. The students developed practical geographical fieldwork skills including landscape analysis, sediment height measurements and the combination of ranging poles and clinometers to measure the angle of the beach. For a trip on the 10th October the sun was very warm and the ice cream at the end of the day very welcome!

The students were all exemplary in their behaviour and conduct and, as always, represented the College brilliantly – we look forward to the next round of off-site events in making the world make sense with the Geography department.
