What is Destination Data?

Destination data is information about what our students go on to do after leaving Crookhorn College — whether that's college, sixth form, apprenticeships, employment, or other pathways. It gives us a clear picture of the next steps our students take and helps us understand how we can improve our careers programme.

Each year Hampshire county Council share a snapshot of our destination data of our leavers as of the 1st of November. This means it includes students who started college or training but left before this date.

Activity Survey Year 11 Leavers from Crookhorn College

We monitor and share our post 16 data to educate current students on the destinations available and support previous students where required. The table below shows a snapshot of our former students in the October of the year they left school.
