STEM

1. Attend a STEM event.
2. Create a recipe for a new dish with ingredients linked to the Eatwell Plate. Cook your new dish. Submit a video or highlights of the cooking process.
3. Design a blueprint for an invention and use CAD to build a computer model/design. Include reasons for why you have designed this invention, what its purpose will be and what its USP (unique selling proposition) is.





Science

1. Attend 4 Science Clubs.
2. Attend a Science Show (school or external) OR visit a science museum/science event and discuss with your science teacher about what you learned.
3. Create a science poster explaining a scientific phenomenon and present it to a science teacher.





Maths

1. Research a mathematician of your choice and produce a poster including information about who they were, what they did, and why they are important.
2. Take part in Junior Maths Challenge.
3. Complete 10 hours of independent study on MathsWatch.





Literacy

1. Be in the top 10% on the Sparx leaderboard three times.
2. Earn the first Reading Canon badge.
3. Write a creative story using the title 'A day I'll never forget' with a minimum 500 words.





Creative Arts

1. Supporting a college production by attending one of the College performances OR film a small dialogue/musical performance/dance and send it to your creative arts teacher.
2. Taking part in Winter Show as either a performer or crew OR experiment with at least one new technique, material, or style and send in.
3. Committing to an extended creative project and performing in either Dance Live, Spring Gig, Summer Showcase or College Production OR independently develop a personal creative project or portfolio piece.





PE

1. Throughout year 7, attend **1 PE club** of your choice at least **5 times**
2. Throughout Year 7, attend **1 PE club** at least **5 times** and represent the college in at least 3 or more fixtures
3. Throughout Year 7, attend multiple clubs, play in various fixtures, and be an active member of the Sports Council





Humanities

1. Attend Sustainability Squad and share at least one contribution, idea or comment.

OR Complete 3 challenge tasks in your geography lessons

OR Make a poster about a historical figure of your choosing. Include key details about their life and why you chose them.

2. Visit a local geographical site (e.g. beach, river, country park) and take five photographs showing geographical features. Sort them into human and physical.

OR Watch a geography documentary and write a 100 word review or 5 things you learnt.

OR Host a historical dinner party, you need to invite 3 historical guests to dinner, what would meal would you serve them and why and what questions would you ask your guests?
