Dear Parent/Carer

**Re: Year 10 - GCSE Results Day, Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August 2020**

As you are aware, according to Government guidelines regarding social distancing, and as part of lockdown measures, the College site has been closed since 20<sup>th</sup> March 2020 to all students except the children of key workers and, since 15<sup>th</sup> June 2020, Year 10 pupils on a rotational basis. College closure has also meant that parents and other visitors have not been allowed on site. It is anticipated that such protective measures will be required in College for the foreseeable future.

Last year, for the first time, Year 10 students came to the College site in August in order to collect their examination results for their 'Early Entry' subjects and celebrate with their peers and teachers. Although this is clearly not possible in the normal way due to the current climate, we would like to give Year 10 students the opportunity to collect their examination results in person.

Members of the Senior Leadership Team, Heads of House and Mrs Wilson - Careers Leader will be on site to give out the results and answer any questions or concerns students may have.

If, for whatever reason, your son/daughter cannot attend on the day, please email [chris.todd@crookhorn.hants.sch.uk](mailto:chris.todd@crookhorn.hants.sch.uk) (Examinations Officer) before the 20<sup>th</sup> August to request that their results are posted home. Please be advised that, as the results are published on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August, it may be some days later that your child's results arrive by post.

If students wish a friend or parent to collect their results this request must be made, by the student, in writing to <mailto:chris.todd@crookhorn.hants.sch.uk> before 20<sup>th</sup> August. The parent/friend must bring appropriate ID to verify their identity. Requests from parents are not acceptable. Any results not collected will be posted home.

We ask that students do not come to the College site on the 20<sup>th</sup> August if they are displaying any of the symptoms of COVID-19 or if they are clinically vulnerable. Students coming on site will need to follow social distancing guidelines whilst following the one-way system in place and family and friends will need to remain off site or in vehicles.

Details of the appeals process and the Autumn GCSE exam series will be available with the results.

We ask that students arrive in the following time slots:
