PRIVACY SETTINGS - INSTAGRAM

This lock icon lets you know if your account is private.

STEP 1



On your Instagram profile page select the Menu icon in the top right corner. STEP 2



From here you can select the Settings option. You can find this at the top. STEP 3



Next select the Privacy option in the settings menu.




PRIVACY SETTINGS - INSTAGRAM

STEP 4



From here you can set your account to private by clicking the button at the top.

STEP 5



Finally, you can review who follows your posts and stories by selecting **Review Followers**.

TOP TIPS



PRIVACY SETTINGS - SNAPCHAT




You can access your **Snapchat profile** by clicking on the **profile icon** located at the top.

STEP 2



On your Snapchat profile page select the **Settings Menu** icon in the top right corner.

STEP 3



Scroll down to the WHO CAN... section to set your privacy options.




PRIVACY SETTINGS - SNAPCHAT

STEP 4



Set both of these to **My Friends.**This ensures that only people who have been approved by you will be able to send you snaps.

STEP 5



Finally enable **Ghost Mode**. This will prevent Snapchat from sharing your location.

TOP TIPS

CHOOSE YOUR FRIENDS WISELY

Don't add people you don't know to your friends list. Sometimes Snapchat will recommend other users based on mutual friendships between them and one of your best friends. Since Snapchat can be a very personal experience, stick to adding the people you know you can trust.

REMOVE AND REPORT

Repeated attempts at contact from people you've ignored can count as harassment. It's best to simply block them. You also shouldn't feel bad about blocking people in your contacts list who send you unwanted or inappropriate snaps.

THINK BEFORE POSTING


Don't send inappropriate snaps. Even though you trust the friend or friends who you're snapping, you have to assume that anyone can see the snap as soon as it has been opened.

AM I GIVING AWAY TOO MUCH?

Keep your location private. While it can be tempting to add a snap with a geofilter to a public story, it's safer to use filters that don't reveal your location.



PRIVACY SETTINGS - TIKTOK




From the home screen select the Me tab at the bottom to get to your profile.

STEP 2



On your TikTok profile page select the Menu icon in the top right corner.


STEP 3



Next select the Privacy option in the settings menu.

STEP 4



From here you can set your account to private by clicking the button at the top.

STEP 5



Finally, you can review who has access to your videos at the bottom of the page.


On your Facebook user profile page select the **More** option

STEP 2




Next select View Privacy Shortcuts from the pop up menu

STEP 3




Next select


On the next screen click on the Choose Audience Tab and select Friends Only

STEP 5



On the Profile screen click on each tab and select either Only Me or Friends Only

STEP 6



Go through each of these and make sure that NOTHING is set to Public

PROFILE PICTURES






When uploading images as profile pictures please note that Facebook posts these as **Public** images by default.

LIMITING OLD POSTS

You can change all old posts on your timeline that you've previously shared as Public to Friends by using the Limit Old Posts option. You can find this option by going to Settings > Account Settings > Privacy > Limit the audience for posts you've shared with Friends of Friends or Public, and click the button.

You can change who can see your content on individual posts by using the drop down menu in the top right corner
